his role as an Interventional Radiologist at the end of November 2008. He will remain a valued partner in Grand Traverse Radiologists and will continue to advance our practice in CT angiography.

We recently welcomed Dr. James Picotte to our interventional service. He is a fellow from William Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak and joined the practice on July 28, 2008. He is well trained in Interventional Radiology with an added interest in Interventional Oncology. He brings to us the latest in localized cancer treatment options, which we are offering to patients throughout Northern Michigan.

Clinic Services

Our Clinic, as before, continues to serve as an avenue for direct referral of patients being considered for minimally invasive percutaneous therapy. The clinic will also serve as a means for patient follow-up after therapy.

Outpatients will be accepted for evaluation, work-up and therapy of a wide variety of conditions including:

1. Peripheral vascular disease, both occlusive and aneurysmal. Reno vascular hypertension and renal insufficiency, mesenteric ischemia and carotid occlusive disease.
2. Gynecologic interventions such as uterine fibroid embolization and treatment for pelvic congestion syndrome.
3. Vertebroplasty and Kyphoplasty for painful osteoporotic and neoplastic compression fractures.
4. Minimally invasive local oncology therapy.
5. Consultation for the full spectrum of Interventional Radiology procedures.

As with all invasive procedures, pre-procedural patient evaluation and counseling are important in establishing which patients are appropriate candidates. Post procedural counseling and follow-up are also crucial to create long-term success. We will keep the primary referring physician fully apprised of the patient's status during the work-up and follow-up with complete, frequent communications. We work cooperatively with our surgical, cardiology and subspecialty colleagues and, when needed, referrals can be facilitated.

Clinic Location and Resources

The clinic is located at 312 Munson Professional Building at Munson Medical Center. The clinic operates daily from 7:30am to 4:00pm and can be reached by phoning 231.935.2861. Questions or referrals can also be directed to any of the four interventional radiologists by paging us through the Munson operator. We continue to offer around-the-clock coverage for inpatients and emergencies and are available 365 days a year.
